TERMS AND CONDITIONS / GENERAL INFORMATION

DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT: A \$500 deposit is required at the time of your reservation. Reservations must be made by May 10, 2004. Balance is due no later than June 11, 2004.

FOR GUESTS WHO CHOOSE TO BOOK ACCOMMODATIONS ON THEIR OWN:

Cost per person, without hotel: \$1635.

All coach departures will be prompt and will be from the Royal Horseguards, which is located at the southern end of Theatreland, between Trafalgar Square / CharingCross / The Strand and the Thames, near the Embankment Underground Station. Please see full schedule for more details.

V.I.P. TOURS OF NEW YORK: Our tour is being custom-designed by Joseph Rosenberg, Ph.D., President of V.I.P. Tours of New York. He will accompany group on all sponsored tours and events.

NOTE: V.I.P. Tours of New York makes it a policy never to make changes to the cost of a program after it is has been set. However, the value of the dollar is one element over which they have no control. At the moment (late March), the weakened dollar has stabilized somewhat. Should the value of the dollar resume its slide and continue to weaken against the English Pound between now and June 1st, V.I.P. Tours of New York will have no choice but to add a surcharge. Before adding a surcharge, V.I.P. Tours of New York will genuinely make very effort to tweak the program, without affecting its quality, in order not to have to increase the cost of the program.

NOT INCLUDED IN THE PRICE OF THE TOUR: Medical and cancellation insurance; Airfare, to and from any destination, including the designated LHAT flights from Philadelphia to London and back; Meals and beverages not specifically stated; in-town transportation (for free time); all items of a personal nature and items not listed under the section "TOUR PACKAGE PRICE INCLUDES".

INSURANCE: We very strongly encourage you to obtain trip cancellation and travel medical insurance. Such insurance may pay for medivac and other 'away-from-home' medical treatments not covered by your regular insurance policies. **Your payments for this tour are non-refundable. If for ANY reason you think you may not be able to travel to London, trip cancellation insurance is strongly suggested.** Cancellation and trip medical insurance are generally handled through local travel agencies. Or, if you go to a search engine, such as Google, and enter "Travel Insurance", you will come up with a myriad of companies that offer both medical and cancellation insurance policies.

CONTRIBUTION: A \$200 tax-deductible contribution to The League of Historic American Theatres is included in the cost of the Tour.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS: All requests for cancellations must be received in writing. Prior to May 10, 2004, any and all cancellations received will be subject to a cancellation fee of \$100, (20% of deposit). After May 10, 2004, there will be no refunds of deposits for any reason whatsoever, including but not limited to; illness, flight cancellations, political situation, or change of mind. If cancellation is made after payment has been made in full the following conditions apply: On or before June 11, 2004 the balance is refunded, but the entire deposit is forfeited. After June 11, 2004, there will be no refunds of any money paid for any reason whatsoever, including but not limited to, illness, flight cancellations, political situation, or change of mind.
